As Citizens we will:

Explore what it means to be responsible and what you may be responsible for as you grow.

As Readers we will:

Continue to use Read, Write, Inc program or explore poetry and read poems that are about food.

As Musicians we will:

Explore rhymes and rhythms. We will also learn the rhyme "London's Burning".

As Authors we will:

Be writing our own food poems. We will look at how a poem is set out and use rhyming words in our own poems.

As Designers we will:

Investigate different types of houses, looking at the features of a Tudor house. We will then design and build our own Tudor house.





How did the Great Fire of London start?

As Programmers we will:

Be using the program word to write digitally. We will open and save our own work.

As Scientists we will:

Explore and investigate properties of different materials and identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials. Investigate what would be a suitable material for a boat.

As Historians we will:

Be exploring how London has changed over time and learn about how the Great Fire of London started.
