We have enjoyed a week full of learning. This has included Amethyst Class taking part in a live video call with Picture News to discuss current news. Topaz Class have started to practise their Nativity play and Emerald Class have enjoyed science experiments amongst other things this week.

This week we have had a visit from our Local Authority, she completed a learning walk and looked at pupil books. She said that the school was lovely and calm and the children were excellent. They were enthusiastic about their learning. We have reviewed our teaching of French since our Ofsted report and Mrs Parry now teaches this across Key Stage 2 instead of a company that we brought in last year. The children enjoy lessons and the books show super learning and good progress.

Active English and Spelling

We deliver Active English and Active spelling in school, which helps children to develop spelling and grammar in a fun way. Today we had a review from an English specialist and her feedback was very positive. Our children are learning new vocabulary and spellings, which is evident in their writing. We have been asked to be a 'showcase school' in the future for these programmes which is a fantastic achievement and testament to our staff's hard work and dedication to improving standards in school.

Fun Run

We cannot thank you enough for the generous contributions you have all made to the sponsored run to raise money for Ugandan children. We have raised the amazing amount of £1150.00 which has enabled us to sponsor two children for a year, buy mattresses for 6 children, sent boxes of gifts for 4 children plus help furnish dormitories, buy mosquito nets and school uniform.
