For next year, we will have 73 children across four classes (a combined reception/year 1, a single year 2, combined years 3 and 4, and combined years 5 and 6). We have a bespoke curriculum, using Read Write Inc. and White Rose Maths, and with external support from Lincoln City Foundation and Lincolnshire Music Service for PE and music. All teachers take an active part in subject leadership and are encouraged to develop their knowledge of new subjects and primary phases.
