This term we will be exploring the History topic 'Why did Guy Fawkes plan the gunpowder plot?'

Our learning challenges for this term are:

To know when the gunpowder plot took place.

To sequence the main events of the Gunpowder Plot.

To know what life was like in the past

To find out about how the Gunpowder Plot started and some of the problems the plotters encountered.

To know what happened to the plotters after the Gunpowder Plot was discovered.

To know who Guy Fawkes was.

In R.E we will: be answering the question How are stories and celebrations linked?

In Computing we will: be using the Paint app on our laptops to create a digital painting.

As mathematicians we will: be learning about place value within 20 and then we will move on to learning how to add and subtract within 20.



Why did Guy Fawkes plan the gunpowder plot?

As scientists we will: be learning about living things and their habitats.



As designers we will: be learning about mechanisms with a focus on levers.

As musicians we will: be taught by Miss Clifford from Lincolnshire Music Service on Thursday afternoons. We will be developing early musicianship skills learning all about rhythms.

As readers we will: be reading daily within our phonics lessons but we will also be sharing our class book together daily for 15 minutes.



In PSHE we will: be learning about keeping ourselves healthy by looking after our emotions.

As athletes we will: have PE on a Monday afternoon with Miss Steer and we will be developing our agility, balance and coordination. On Thursday afternoon we will be taught by Coach George from Lincoln City Foundation, and we will be developing our fundamental movement skills including how to find space and evade defenders.
