## Dear Parents and Year 3 and 4 children.

This term we will be exploring the History topic 'Would you want to step back into the ages'?

# Our learning challenges for this term are:

To know where to locate The Stone Age on a timeline

To know how people in the Stone age communicated through art

To know about Stone Age homes and their materials

To know about The Stone Age diet

To know what Skara Brae was

To know what changes occurred in The Iron Age and The Bronze Age

To Know how Britain changed between the beginning of the stone age and the iron age

To Know the main differences between the stone, bronze and iron ages.

In R.E we will: be exploring the question, 'How do Christians show they belong?'

In Computing we will: be learning the topic 'Connecting Computers' where we will explore what makes a digital device and how they can help us.

As athletes we will: have our PE days on a Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon.

# As mathematicians we will:

Be exploring the place value of either 3 Maths or 4-digit numbers. We will be partitioning numbers, placing them on a number line and comparing and ordering them. Later in the term, we will move on to addition and subtraction before multiplication and division. Please encourage your child to practise their times tables either on TT Rockstars or on my personal favourite, 'Hit the Button' on the Top Marks website.

Would you want to step back into the ages?



As authors we will: be retelling the very well-known story of the Three Little Pigs however we will consider the point of view of the wolf!

We will be using the text, 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs'. Later in the term we will also create information texts about The Stone Age, including headings and subheadings.

As scientists we will: be learning about nutrition for both animals and humans. We will also learn about skeletons and muscles and their importance!

### As artists we will be:

Recreating prehistoric art including cave paintings and animal sketches.

#### As musicians we will:

Have sessions led by Mr Roberts from The Lincolnshire Music Service each Wednesday afternoon!

As readers we will: be reading 'The Wild Way Home' as our class book. In our reading sessions we will explore Roald Dahl's 'Revolting Rhymes' and 'George's Marvellous Medicine'.

In French we will: be learning to ask and answer general greetings and questions. We will learn to say how we are feeling, state our name and age and count to 10!

In PSHE we will: be learning all about our brain and how it works in 'My Happy Mind'.
