Our learning challenges for this term are:

LO: To know the names of and locate countries and cities in the northern hemisphere.

LO: To know and locate Roman settlements.

LO: To know and locate Roman ruins in Lincoln.

LO: To compare Roman Lincoln to Lincoln today.

LO: To create a guide of Roman Lincoln.

LO: To use atlases, maps and satellite images.

LO: To use fieldwork skills to navigate around Lincoln.

In R.E we will: be learning all about Islam. The two key questions we are going to be exploring are 'What is the purpose of visual symbols in a mosque?' And 'What do the main concepts of Islam reveal about the nature of Allah?'

In Computing we will: be learning to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and we will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos.

As mathematicians we will:
be focussing on

As scientists we will: be focusing on the topic 'Animals including Humans'. We will be learning all about nutrition and the importance of having a balanced diet.
