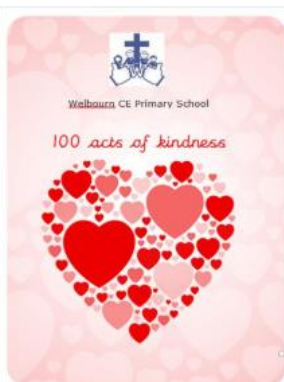
Attendance
