Topaz Class enjoyed adding and ordering numbers with Smoulder the Dragon and creating their castle role play area.



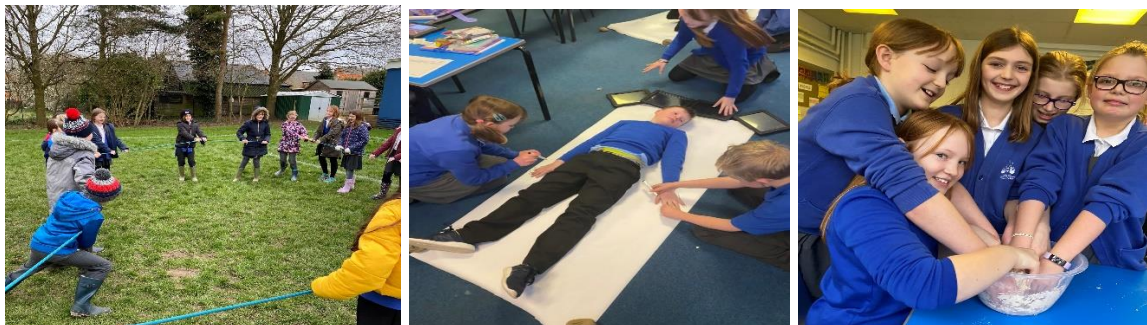
Emerald class enjoyed exploring colour mixing and creating paintings in the style of Mark Roscoe and creating timelines in history whilst exploring castles.
