## Let's take a look at our learning this week ...

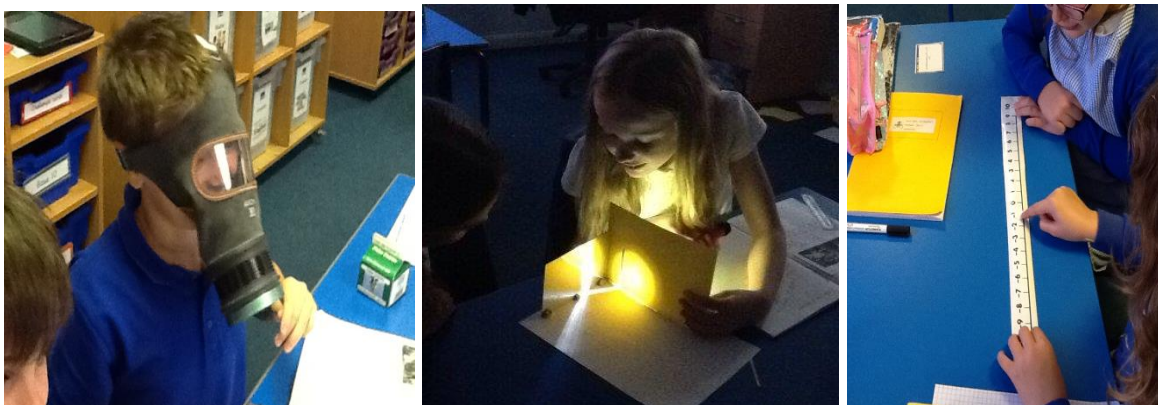
Topaz Class enjoyed exploring St Chad's church where they learnt about Holy Communion and listening to stories and music from black people as part of Black History month.
