Topaz Class have enjoyed their new topic 'People who help us'. They have created superheroes, enjoyed drawing portraits of their friends and been measuring their bodies.








Emerald Class have been painting self-portraits, pretending to be Roman soldiers, making shields and learning about solids, liquids and gases in science.
