Relentless and excellent teaching, assessment and delivering catch up interventions have ensured that our children have reached the expected standard.

Let's take a look at our learning this week ...

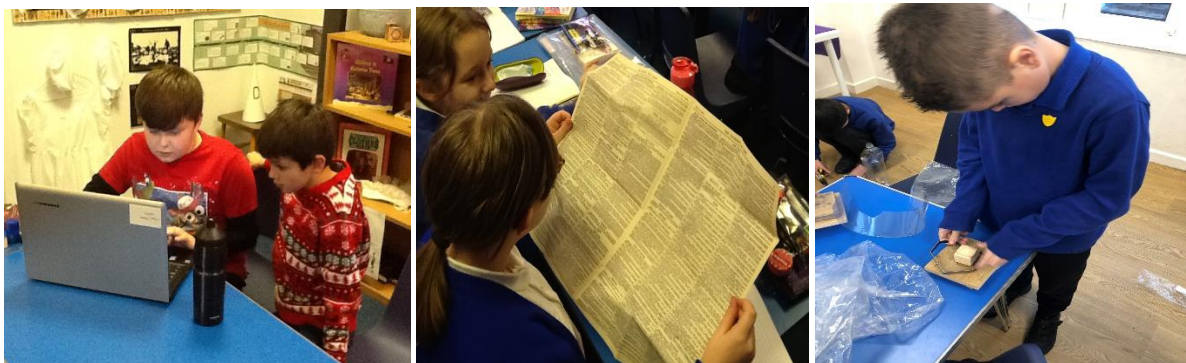
Topaz Class enjoyed celebrating Hanukkah, learning about compass points and creating maps.
