Dear Parents and Carers,

Being part of the Kyra Teaching School Alliance enables us to be part of a Peer Review group where a group of schools review each other's schools with a particular focus to identify areas of strength and areas to improve. We are currently working with West Wold Federation (Grasby and Caistor Primary Schools) and Infinity Academy, working with Pinchbeck and Spalding Primary schools. Our focus was on learning behaviours, support for pupils with SEND, how we challenge pupils and support pupils to self-regulate and be resilient. The Leaders of the school spent the morning in school and spoke to children, staff, observed lessons and looked at work. Some of the feedback included:

*'The deployment of ALL adults to support learning was exceptional. Relationships were clearly secure to enable ALL children to flourish. The work set was sufficiently challenging and children were keen to have a go, being secure in the knowledge that they could succeed and if they needed help, they could use the range of clear strategies to help themselves. Learning was scaffolded and extended with carefully worded questions from all staff.'*

We are extremely proud that leaders from other schools have recognised how focused and engaged our children are and how their learning behaviours are excellent. We are going to take part in a workshop to develop ideas on how we can develop children's responses further and develop confidence when sharing ideas in class.

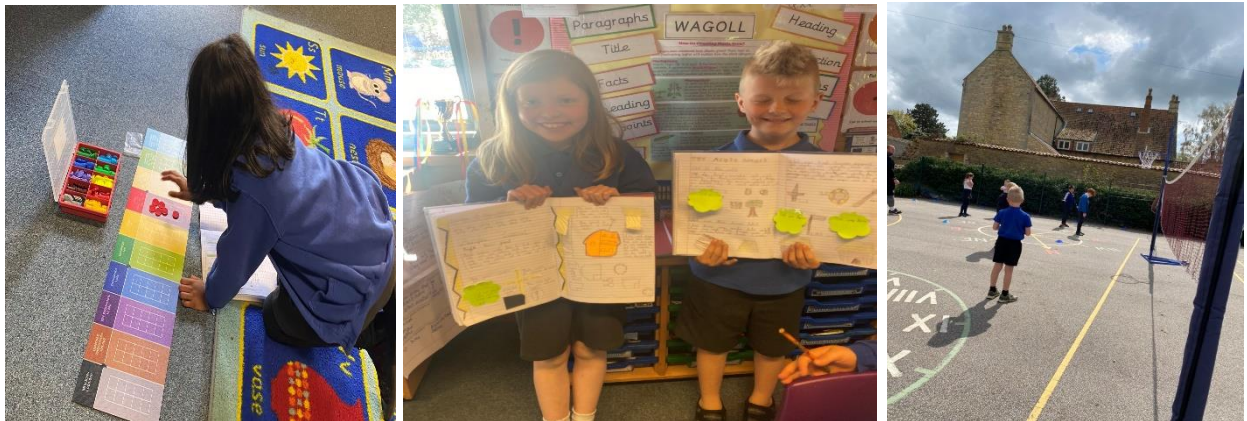
