### Dear Parents and Carers,

The children have had an exciting week. It began with Sports day and a visit from the Ice-cream van, a Roots to Food experience day to develop cooking skills and try new recipes from around the world and ended by watching the Amethyst end of year performance, Cinderella Rockerfella. Obviously, in between, they have been busy finishing off the term's topics and continued their core lessons.

It was a shame to see the football result on Sunday evening but it has enabled us to provide an opportunity, during worships, to discuss the importance of good sportsmanship, teamwork, resilience and most importantly kindness.

As you have probably seen in the news, new guidance from the Department for Education has been issued in response to the Governments changes from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July. With 3 days left of term and rising cases both in schools and the local area, we have decided to keep all protocols and procedures the same. In September, I will send a new, revised risk assessment and update you of the changes.

On Wednesday, we had a phone call from Ofsted to inform us that they wanted to inspect our school the next day. However, with staff members isolating, they agreed to defer the inspection until September.

On Monday, the children will take part in 'Move up morning' where they will do a craft activity and think about their hopes for next year. We are looking forward to welcoming the new Reception children for a short period of time in the outdoor area on Monday too.

You will have received your child's annual report this evening. It is a lot shorter than it would usually be because we have had limited time in school. We have covered the statutory requirements set out by the Department for Education and included catch up priorities for September. These will be addressed with tuition, intervention and classroom provision and communicated in the Autumn term. If you do still require a conversation with your child's class teacher regarding the content of the report, please contact the school office.

A polite reminder that this was the last week for clubs due to next week's events after school. However, as always, if you need childcare provision, we can help if you let us know as soon as possible. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Mr Clarke, Anna Blount, the Carre's coaches and all of our staff for delivering a variety of clubs and experiences for our children this year. We are still awaiting confirmation from various providers for clubs for September so the list will be sent out on the first day of term and clubs will begin week commencing 13.09.21.
