Dear Parents and Carers,

We've had such a wonderful week! We started with launching our new Christmas shop, which was a success! Thank you to the Friends of School for their support in purchasing the items. We then enjoyed Christmas parties, Christingles and more! We had such fun on our Rudy walk around the village and sang to the residents in both care homes from outside. It was very moving to watch their faces brighten as the children sang. On Sunday Rev Chris will deliver a virtual Christingle service and welcomes you all to join. It would be great to see you all.

Last week we had an external moderator work with each teacher to review Reading, Writing and Maths. We are pleased to say that progress in these subjects is looking extremely positive and the evidence across the range was complimented by the moderator. As a school, she could see huge improvements to the children's learning since beginning her work with us in 2019. Well done to all of our children and staff for their hard work.

This term intervention and 'catch up' has taken place in classes with various focus areas such as well-being, maths, spelling, reading, etc. The intervention cycle will be reviewed during the first week back and a new cycle of support will begin on the following week. Parents will be notified if their child will have additional support. We have been given £80.00 per pupil from the Government to help with 'catch up' due to the pandemic and will be investing in some extra intervention which will begin in January. Please continue to encourage your child to read every day and practise their times tables or number facts on TTrockstars.

Next term we will amend the start and end times for school drop off and pick-ups. We are aware that some parents who have children in both Topaz or Emerald and Amethyst need to wait until 3.30pm in the cold or rain. A little reminder that all classes can now be dropped off at 8.45am and the gate closes at 9.00am for register. Activities and interventions begin at 8.45am. All children can now be picked up at 3.30pm. Please remember to model social distancing to our children.
