Dear Parents and Carers,

What a busy week we have had! This week has been 'Art Week' so we have been learning weaving and sewing skills in preparation for an outdoor art project for our school fence. The children have also enjoyed doing outside 'forest school' activities linked to these techniques. Over the next few weeks, our children will continue to work with Mr Clarke to create large scale woven items to decorate our school. Thank you once again to the Friends of School for funding our art week.

As you may have seen, we have had to make the difficult decision to stop after school provision for now. We understand that this may make things difficult for parents but this decision was not taken lightly – we have to consider staffing, Covid safety measures and pupil numbers. Staff have had to be redeployed to cleaning and numbers were too low to be able to employ someone new. We will review these changes in preparation for Term 2 and have already booked some paid clubs, which will begin soon.

As you may have heard, a number of schools in Lincolnshire have had to close 'bubbles' or year groups due to Covid cases. Thank you for your support in following our protocols and ensuring that you monitor your child's symptoms. Please remember that if your child has a minor cold, they are still able to come into school. We want our children in school as much as possible so that we can continue to work on well-being, routines and learning. However, if your child develops a new persistent cough and/ or temperature and/or loss of taste or smell, you must keep them at home and contact us as soon as possible by phoning the school office.

If your child is absent due to being ill or isolating, all work will be allocated via Microsoft Teams. Also a selection of videos, games and tasks can be accessed via the class pages. If you are still not able to log in or have lost login details, please contact the school office.

We are extremely proud of our children for adapting to our new changes in school. We are excited to launch our new topics next week and learn new skills and knowledge. There will be a curriculum overview sent out to parents next week. Stay safe and take care!

Attendance

Pick up and drop off times

Please note that children in all classes are to be dropped off between 8.45 and 9.00 and collected between 3.15 and 3.30. Please ensure that you keep 2m distance at all times and use the allocated gates and entrances.

Food in school

From September, due to allergies in school, the following foods will not be allowed to be brought into school:

- Kiwi fruit
- Hummus
- Boiled eggs, egg sandwiches

Please note that any children who are in receipt of Free School Meals and who are in Years Reception to Year 2 can also receive a free packed lunch. You need to order these with Good Lookin Cookin in advance. We will review whether we can safely serve hot school lunches in preparation for Term 2.
