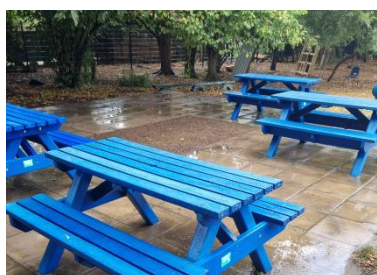


Dear Parents and Carers
