Dear Parents and Carers,

Today is World Kindness day and what a better way to show our kindness than to raise money for a good cause. Today our children enjoyed dressing up in 'wacky clothes or hair' to raise money for Children in Need. Thank you for allowing your child to take part and for the generous contributions made to school. Continuing with the theme of kindness, I would like to thank our staff for staying late, doing extra hours and going that extra mile to ensure that we could remain open to all bubbles over the past 2 weeks, although we have been 4 staff members down in school.

I would also like to thank our parents who attended our Friends of School meeting last night. Please view the details below of their plans. We are extremely grateful for all of the extra opportunities, resources and experiences that we can provide for our children with the extra money that they raise.

As you know, we have been working hard to ensure that children continue to feel happy and safe in school. Our recovery curriculum has included having extra PSHE lessons in school and we have provided intervention or support to children who need it. We focus on feelings in Collective worship and have stories linked to scenarios or feelings to aid discussion. In school children are encouraged to talk to adults or use worry boxes/monsters in school. These are very difficult times so we are trying as much as possible to ensure that our children enjoy lessons and have opportunities to talk.

We are currently part of a range of initiatives in school to promote wellbeing and safety. These include:

- EMBRACE a programme of lessons to explore diversity, race and ethnicity
- Assemblies from Inspire+ with well known Olympians
- Lincolnshire Road Safety Officers partnership (led by our School Road Safety officers)
- Lincolnshire Online Safety workshops
- Anti-bullying week

One way that we hope to promote joy and laughter in school is through further enhancing opportunities in school. We have our celebration worship each week where we dance and share achievements. We are also planning a monthly birthday celebration in school. We know how disappointing it is for children to miss out on birthday parties with friends during lockdown so we are bringing the party to Welbourn! On the last day of each month, we will celebrate all of the birthdays in that month. If a child has missed their birthday, they will be celebrated this month. Our children also enjoy spending time with Milo, our pet tortoise as a weekly treat.

Finally, all of our Christmas festivities are still going to take place in the month of December. You will have more information about this very soon. Take care and stay safe!
