### **Statutory Assessments**

This week the children in Year 1 and Year 4 have completed their statutory tests. Year 1 children completed their Phonics Screening Checks and Year 4 have completed their Multiplication Checks. Results on these tests and KS2 SATs will be shared with parents in the children's end of year reports.

### **EYFS**

Mrs Puttock has been lucky to have the support from a EYFS specialist in school this week and she is now busy adapting the provision to enhance it for the children. One of the large projects we would like to develop over the summer is the redevelopment of the outdoor classroom. Watch this space for a wish list of things that you may be able to help us source.

### **Weather**

It's lovely to see the sunshine making an appearance again, and it's due to be with us next week too. Please can I ask that children come to school with suncream applied and some available for them to reapply before they go outside and to bring a sunhat.
