Experience of delivering intervention or small group learning would be desirable.

An understanding of how children learn and a knowledge of what works for children with Mathematics and English difficulties. A good knowledge of the requirements for EYFS and KS1 would be desirable.

This post is to commence as soon as possible.

The successful applicant will be expected to:

- Support a child with additional needs under the guidance of the Class Teacher but also to adapt learning appropriately using their own initiative and professional judgement.
- Deliver small interventions to enable individual children to meet their targets
- Carry out baseline and post intervention assessments
- Prepare resources and materials
- Complete intervention paperwork, recording progress and concerns, and evaluate these in order to plan next steps in learning
- Liaise with Class Teacher and SENDCo

The post holder needs:

- To have experience of working within an Early Years and Key Stage 1
- To be trained in delivering high quality phonics teaching
- To have knowledge and understanding of child development
- To have knowledge and understanding of how to support children with specific learning difficulties
- Previous experience of 1:1 support (preferable but not essential)
- To work well within a team and have good communication skills
- To have an understanding or experience of supporting well-being and the mental health of children
- To have a good understanding of how to deal with children with social and emotional needs
- To work with outside agencies to implement strategies and act upon advice given

• Excellent interpersonal skills, being able to communicate effectively with pupils, staff and parents;

- A drive to ensure children receive the appropriate support to achieve their potential;
- Experience of working in a similar role;
- The ability to work on their own initiative and as part of a team;
- Flexibility and adaptability;
- A willingness to learn and develop existing skills;
- A sense of humour;
- A willingness to 'go the extra mile'.
- The ability to motivate and support the needs of vulnerable learners.
